You are being provided this additional risk disclosure statement because on your application you fall into one or more of the following categories:

- You are not between 21 and 65 years old;
- You do not have at least one year of futures investment experience;
- Your annual income is less than \$25,000;
- Your net worth is less than \$50,000;
- Your liquid net worth is less than \$15,000; and/or
- This will be an IRA account

While Dorman is prepared to open your account, it is necessary to advise you to reconsider this investment. Based on your personal information and/or investment experience, futures and/or options trading might be too risky of an investment strategy. The loss in trading commodity futures can be substantial. You should carefully consider whether such trading is suitable for you in light of your circumstances and financial resources. The high degree of leverage that is obtainable in futures trading because of the small margin requirements can work against you as well as for you.
